Remanufactured components

All Komatsu Reman components are rebuilt from scratch in dedicated facilities located in Brisbane and Perth, to original factory tolerances and criteria.

Komatsu Reman products include engines and engine components, transmissions, power modules, final drives, cylinders, hydraulic pumps, motors, differentials, electric wheel motors and more. Our Reman service includes the option of replacing your components from our existing Reman stocks, or applying the Komatsu Reman process to components taken from your own fleet.

We also offer a repair and return option if you wish to have your own component rebuilt.

Distribution centres

We carry more than **75,000** different parts with a parts inventory value of over **\$265** million.

State of the art **Inventory Control Systems** to monitor and maintain stock levels based on planning with customer's demand history and strategic stocking.

World Class Distribution Centres located in Perth, Sydney and Brisbane, supported by warehouses close to customer sites.

Being constructed on a 3.8 hectare site adjacent to its existing Queensland head office, service, training and customer support facility, the new DC covers nearly 17,500m², with an order picking storage area of just under 14,500m², and an extra large parts/components storage area of over 2000m².

The Distribution centres are paper less warehouses and all transactions are managed digitally with handheld devices that read barcodes and connect with mobile printers that print on demand to ensure control from start of transaction till finally packaged. The information is passed onto the freight management system, to organise and plan the final stage of the delivery process. The main benefit is to reduce time lag in transactional data capturing which increase inventory accuracy and transaction information. This benefits our customer with accurate feedback on order executions and parts availability.

The Vertical lift storage machines have several benefits over traditional carousel type vertical storage solutions. The density of storage is very efficient and a typical Vertical lift storage machine application in Komatsu Australia will store 10 000 different SKU's. The Wacol DC applies 7 of these machines to store most of our small parts. The Vertical lift storage machines are connected to our warehouse management system (WMS).

The WMS will give instruction to the Vertical lift Storage machine to present parts for picking based on algorithms that drive the most efficient picking sequence. This allows maximum efficiency in the execution of the transaction. The Vertical lift storage machines are grouped in cells and are interconnected with conveyors transporting orders between Vertical lift Storage machine and packing process.

Distribution by Toll provides access to **50+ planes on stand-by** and national logistics network.
